MODULE 1

This one-day course addresses the particular issues in caring for children who have suffered bereavement and loss. It is geared to support the training needs of school teaching and ancillary staff as well as health professionals and others in related fields.

We hope that a variety of disciplines will attend and provide a broad experience base for the workshops.

The primary focus will be on loss through bereavement though much of the material will be applicable to other losses. Difficult and sensitive issues will be addressed in a safe environment and will give participants an opportunity to confirm their existing capabilities, to enhance them further and to avoid unhelpful practices.

MODULE 2

This one-day course has been specifically designed for all delegates who have previously attended a Laura Centre Bereavement and Loss training day, i.e. Module 1. It will build on the subjects covered in Module 1, but in addition will cover

- Developing support structures
- Bereavement policies for schools
- Sensitive issues around life threatening conditions
- Anticipated grief

Both the Module 1 and Module 2 days will contain presentations, small group work, group discussions, experiential work and reflection on practice.

They will be run by professional counsellors from The Laura Centre, with many years experience of working with bereaved families.
